

Westview Summer Camp Scholarship applications due NO LATER THAN MARCH 10, 2011

- a. We strive to provide full scholarships for first time campers; the 2nd year, Parents are encouraged to contribute at least 25%; 50% the 3rd year and fully fund their 4th year camper.
- b. All campers are welcome; our scholarships are equal opportunity scholarships and non-denominational. If you know a child who would benefit from a Christian Summer Camp experience, we want to help them.
- c. We need and accept donations from all who are led to sponsor a child to for a camp experience. No amount is too small to help ensure a child enjoys a camp experience.
- d. PARENTS MUST ACCOMPLISH THE ONLINE WESTVIEW PRE-REGISTRATION due to privacy act and other personal and medical information that is required. GUMM cannot access your online account. To pre-register, go to <http://westviewonthejames.org/> and complete as much of the application as possible but DO NOT PAY online; then SAVE your work without entering payment information. When prompted, be sure to select Grace United Methodist – Hartwood as your sponsoring church.
- e. Be sure to remember your LOGIN ID and PASSWORD.
- f. Westview Camp registration is online and can be accomplished free on the computers at Grace United Methodist Church.
- g. Typically, donations to GUMM are tax deductible so, parent contributions, including those fully paying for their child, may be donated directly to GUMM. Consult your tax preparer or Chris Goldsmith, CPA for details. Scholarship funds are limited and we want to ensure that as many children as possible can have a camp experience and you receive the maximum possible tax benefit.
- h. GUMM will make payment to Westview for ALL campers who have properly completed the GUMM application process.
- i. Once you have completed the online Westview registration, Parents need to complete a GUMM scholarship application even if you are fully funding your child. GUMM will then work with the Westview staff to strive for the kids from Grace attend together. - j. Place completed forms in a sealed envelope and put in the GUMM mailbox in the annex by the due date.

For those who complete the GUMM application process, we will offer car-pooling to help defray costs and ensure all who want to attend the Open House are able.
